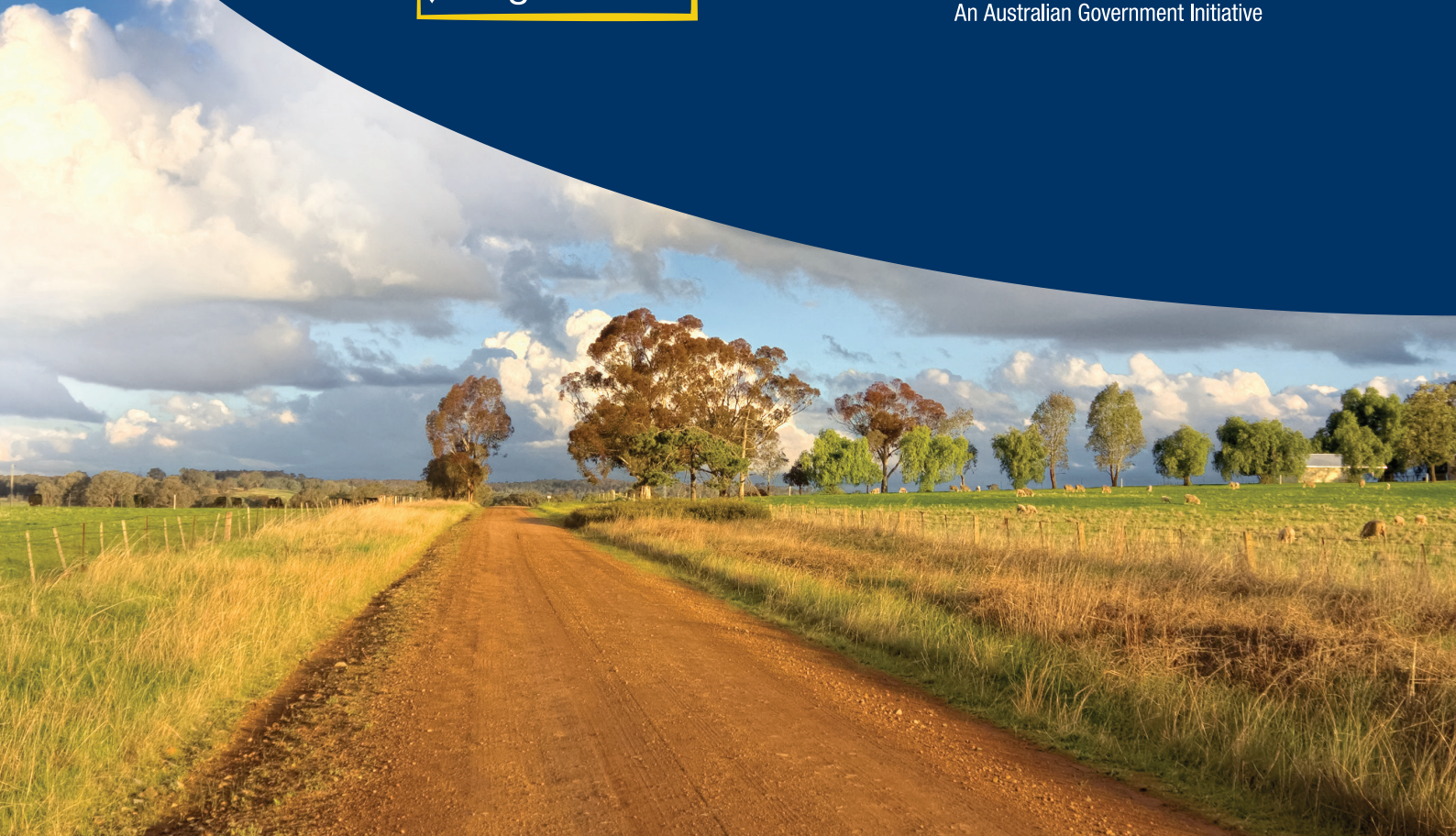


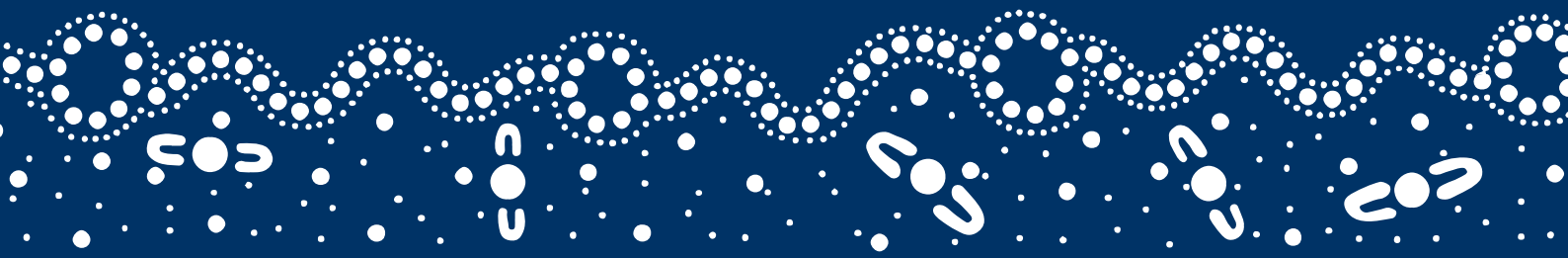

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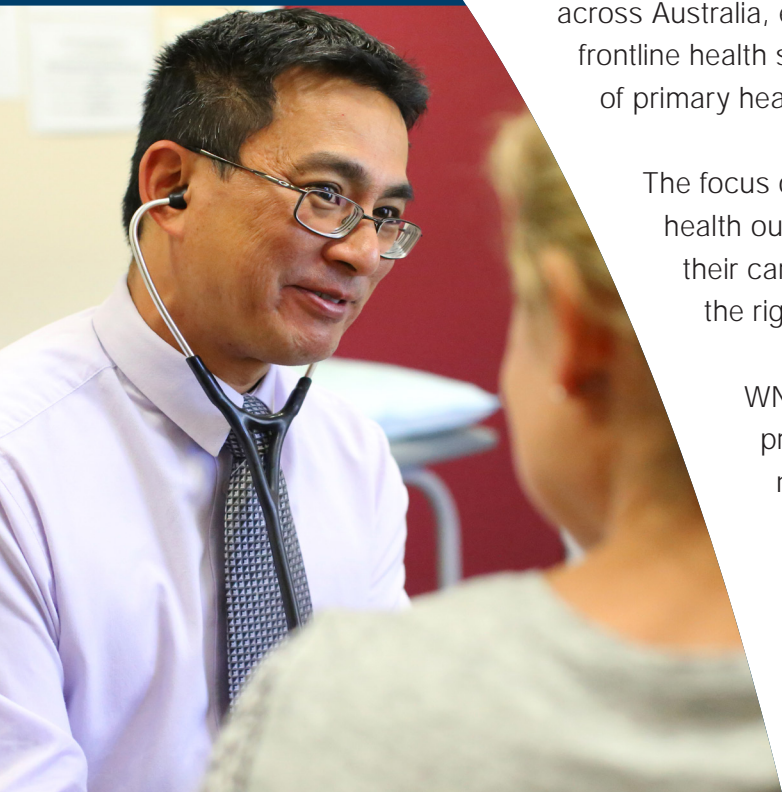

Western Health Alliance Limited, trading as the Western NSW Primary Health Network (WNSW PHN) is one of 31 Primary Health Networks across Australia, established by the Australian Government to support frontline health services and increase the efficiency and effectiveness of primary health care.



The focus of the WNSW PHN is patients who are at risk of poor health outcomes and working to improve the coordination of their care, so they receive the right care in the right place at the right time.

WNSW PHN's role is to drive, support and strengthen primary healthcare in our region, addressing the health needs of our communities. By building partnerships with key stakeholders and working together, we aim to facilitate a better health system, with improved patient outcomes and seamless care.

The WNSW PHN region covers both Far West and Western NSW Local Health Districts.
