The general Neurology Outpatient service is a public hospital Medicare Bulk Billed service for all adult patients with neurological conditions within the Northern Cluster of WNSWLHD. Dr Crossley is resident full time in Dubbo and employed by Dubbo Health Service. A monthly Epilepsy Telehealth clinic is also offered by Dr Crossley in conjunction with subspecialist Epileptologists from Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, for adult patients with complex epilepsy.

The Neurophysiology service is a public hospital Medicare Bulk Billed service provided through the Dubbo Hospital Ambulatory Care, near the old entrance to the hospital on Myall Street. Routine and sleep deprived EEGs are available for patients aged 2 and older. Nerve conduction studies and electromyography are available for patients aged 16 and older. A specific referral form and patient instruction sheets are available - please contact us for copies. Please note ambulatory EEG, single fibre EMG, and evoked potential testing are not currently offered.

Dr Crossley also provides a comprehensive Neurology and Neurophysiology service for inpatients at Dubbo Hospital.
