# Initial management

- All patients require a staging CT [CT chest and abdomen with contrast] prior to review in the FT clinic. Please make sure imaging is available for review at the FT clinic.
- Please do not arrange CT guided biopsy of suspicious lesions/pleural fluid drainage until review by a Specialist in the FastTrack clinic
- Please do not mention "CANCER" [shadow on CXR/CT hence the referral]

## 'Red Flag' items

- · Respiratory distress
- Signs to suggest superior vena cava obstruction



## How to access care in the event of a 'red flag'

 Refer any patient with red flags to the emergency department immediately.
